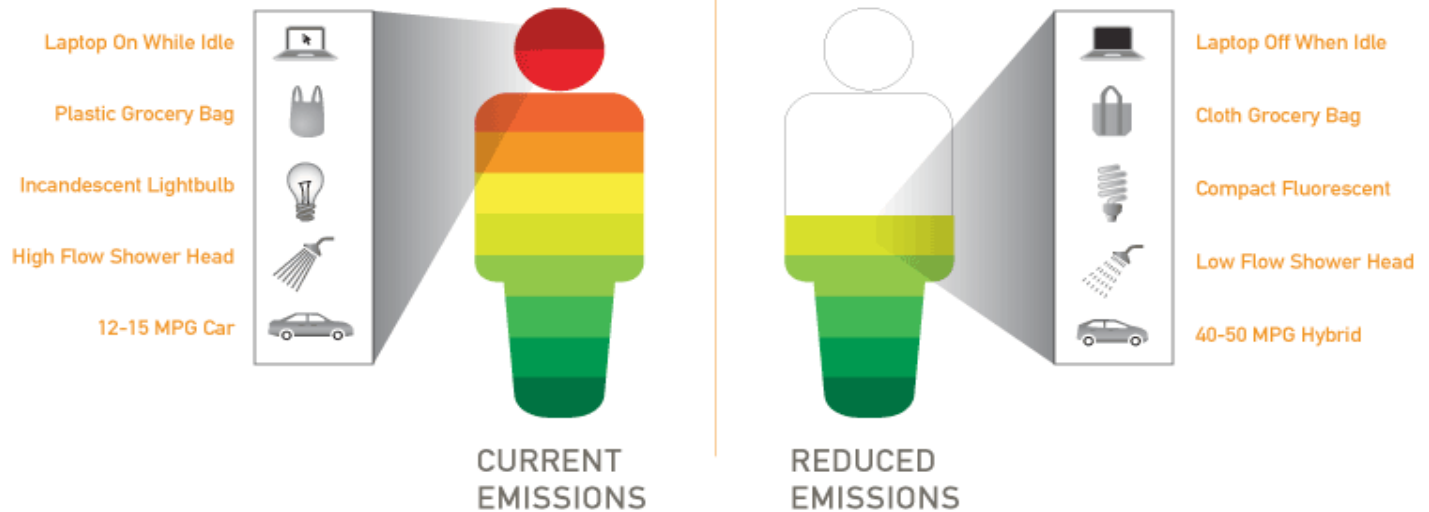


# Energy Conservation and SUSTAINABILITY

## Did you know?

Cornell recently developed the Climate Action Plan, with clear steps for achieving carbon neutrality, or net-zero carbon emissions by 2050. Energy conservation could reduce Cornell's carbon footprint by 16%, eliminating about 53,000 metric tons of carbon emissions each year.

## How YOU can help:

**Volunteer for Lights Off Cornell**, an energy conservation initiative which aims to mobilize students to decrease energy consumption on campus.

**Open blinds or shades** to let natural sunlight brighten up a room instead of a bulb.

**Use lower temperature settings** for laundry. Use a drying rack and cut costs!

**Turn off the lights** when not in use.

**Use "smart" plug strips** for appliances, such as laptops, printers, and cellphone chargers. Turn off and unplug when not in use.

**Report maintenance problems** in the residence halls on the Campus Life website.

**Use Compact Fluorescent Light bulbs**, which are energy-efficient, for all light fixtures.
